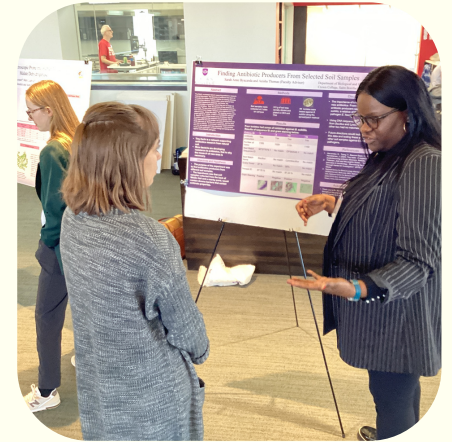


44th Annual Winchell Undergraduate Research Symposium
